Approval of minutes:	Motion 1: Minutes be approved as amended Moffitt/2 nd Siple
Unfinished business KSNA Update	Terri indicated the information published on April 30 th was accurate; specifics of the language are not addressed because they are still negotiating; Plan to have language ready for next session
Regulation Update	Reviewed feedback from the AG's office regarding 60-11-104, 60-11-105, and 60-11-106 (a) adding the citation of the statute and changing management to treatment does not change the intent; consensus to change language to recommended language from the AG (f) language identical to language in the draft approved in 2005; removing (f) would not affect practice since it is really a restatement of

professional care and the concept is already addressed in 60-11-101; if it was read differently by the AG's office now, perhaps the language could lead to future misinterpretation and should just be deleted.

Motion 2: Take forward the suggestions made by the AG's office to define (a) and delete (f) in 60-11-104, 60-11-105, and 60-11-107.

CRNA Issues

Jane reviewed the documents in the packet; the meeting at the end of April discussed development of standing orders and also requested that the BON withdraw the request for the AG's opinion; at the BON strategic planning meeting, there was a motion to withdraw the opinion and it has been formally withdrawn.

Also reviewed the information that was published in the April edition of the KHA Current Report; Deb Stern indicated she will follow up with Jerry Slaughter to get templates for the standing orders.

Mary Blubaugh indicated that staff will need direction from the board about what to tell people when they ask questions and direction about what to put on the web site, possibly including the templates.

HB 596

HB 596 did not go through the house and would have to be reintroduced next year.

New Business Announcements:

Patty reviewed the information in the on-site packet regarding the ANCC credential change, the joint dialog paper, the CNS competencies and the articles related to the DNP and the test being developed by the National Board of Medical Examiners; she also reviewed three resolutions that will be considered at the AMA House of Delegate meeting that starts this weekend: Resolution 214 Doctor of Nursing Practice; Resolution 303 Protection of title

Doctor, Resident and Residency; and
Resolution 716 Model Agreement with ARNPs

ARNP License Application

Reviewed the history of the application received from Faye Evans and the letters received. Reviewed the regulation and statute and discussed the AG response to questions regarding licensure on the basis of certification. Patty noted that NCC information shows that they continued to allow Certificate prepared candidates to sit for the certification exam until January 1, 2007; Kansas education requirement for BSN became effect 7/1/1994 and requirement for MSN effective 7/1/2002.

Faye was out of the country visiting her mother on a trip that had been scheduled many months ago; her husband Weldon was present and shared more about her background and experience.
